I have been asked to clarify my role on the opening committee for Politz as concerns the recent Covid epidemic.

I was involved in the early stages. The role of the committee quickly evolved into a 24 /6 activity with questions and issues arriving hourly. Moreover, the other physician on the committee who has chosen to remain anonymous, is an expert infectious disease consultant from a world class institution. Given my own clinical responsibilities during the pandemic I was unable to be available to the degree that was required. This physician not only provided expert guidance but made himself available whenever needed, which I can testify based on the text messages was from 6 AM to midnight and beyond. This is despite his own clinical load.
